#### DR. GREG CALDWELL, O.D., FAAO

Dr. Greg Caldwell, O.D., is a 1995 graduate of the Pennsylvania College of Optometry. He completed a one-year residency in primary care and ocular disease at the Eye Institute of Philadelphia, PA.

Gregory A. Caldwell, O.D., was elected to the American Optometric Association Board of Trustees at the 116th Annual AOA Congress & 43rd Annual AOSA Conference: Optometry's Meeting® in June 2013.

On top of working with Doctors of Optometry, Dr. Caldwell also works in Duncansville and Johnstown, PA as an ocular disease consultant. He is a member of the Third Party Center Executive Committee for the American Optometric Association, current member and past president of the Board of Directors for the Pennsylvania Optometric Association, president of the Blair/Clearfield Association for the Blind, Fellow at the American Academy of Optometry and a Diplomat of the American Board of Optometry. Dr. Caldwell has been a participant in multiple FDA investigations and has lectured locally and internationally. His international lecturing has taken him to Canada, Norway, Spain, Singapore, Germany, Cyprus, Switzerland, Poland and Austria. His primary focus is the diagnosis and management of anterior and posterior segment ocular disease.

#### DR. JANE ANN GROGG, OD, FAAO

Dr. Jane Ann Grogg is a Clinical Associate Professor at Indiana University School of Optometry and Chief of the Advanced Ocular Care Service. Before returning to her alma mater in 1996, she held a staff position at the prestigious Bascom Palmer Eye Institute. Her clinical interests are in the area of ocular disease with a special interest in glaucoma and retina. She has served as the clinic director of the eye clinic at the IU Health Center for many years, specializing in acute anterior segment disease management. Dr. Grogg serves as program coordinator of the ocular disease residency program providing mentorship and education to the ocular disease resident. In addition to her clinical teaching responsibilities, Dr. Grogg is the instructor of record for the Applied Ocular Therapeutics course and lectures on selected topics in the ocular disease courses.

Dr. Grogg is member of the Optometric Glaucoma Society, a fellow of the Optometric Retinal Society and a fellow of the American Academy of Optometry. She serves on the peer review panel of Clinical and Experimental Optometry. Dr. Grogg has received two university teaching excellence recognition awards during her academic appointment. She lectures at continuing education courses on a local, state and national level and has publications in OVS and Clinical and Experimental Optometry. Dr. Grogg lives in Bloomington, Indiana with her husband and three children. She enjoys traveling, attending her children's athletic events, gardening and caring for a menagerie of family pets.

# Santa Fe, NM & the Drury Plaza Hotel

Santa Fe rests in the foothills of the Sangre de Cristo Mountains, under beautiful blue, sunny skies and with cool, crisp, clean mountain air. Recognized by *Condé Nast Traveler*readers as the #2 destination in the US, Santa Fe is an alluring year-round cultural, culinary, and outdoor destination with a wealth of history. Santa Fe has a vibrant cultural scene and great shopping. As the third largest art market in the US, the City Different is alive with arts, full of amazing food, and has so much for the senses to discover. We invite you to stay at the Drury Plaza Hotel in Santa Fe, to enjoy and explore all that Santa Fe has to offer.

The Drury Plaza Hotel in Santa Fe is located in the heart of downtown Santa Fe on Palace Avenue. The site is adjacent to St. Francis Cathedral, built by Archbishop Jean Baptiste Lamy between 1869 and 1886. In the 1910s, a portion of the property was a dormitory for the Sisters of Charity. The primary facade is from the 1950s St. Vincent's Hospital, designed by John Gaw Meem, and is an excellent example of late Territorial Revival style.

The hospital remained in the building until 1977. After that, the structure housed numerous important offices of the <u>New Mexico Department of Cultural Affairs</u>. The site was also used for movie sets, featured in many major productions as well as offices for the <u>New Mexico Film Commission</u>. All of these past entities are integral parts of Santa Fe's rich history, making it an important landmark for the local community.
