9am-10am What Every Tech Should Know About Ocular Emergencies - ABO-2/NCLE-1/AOA-CPC

Presents an overview of how phone triage and walk-in office visits should be handled from a assistance's perspective. Key elements of triage, and the difference between an emergency and urgent care and testing procedures required before treatment by the optometrist.

10am-11am How to Neutralize a Toxic Employee - ABO-1/AOA-CPC

This lecture is designed to educate Office managers and employers and techniques used to resolve issues with a troubled employee. Documentation and counseling techniques will be discussed and sample forms will be provided. This critical aspect of employment cannot be overlooked. This lecture will focus on what happens when an assistant discovers they are screening a diabetic patient. What they should do to prepare the patient for the doctors examination. The different test, documentation and results for diabetics will be discussed.
