## 2023 NMOA Paraoptometric Continuing Education

### All Paraoptometric CE will be Provided by Lynn E. Lawrence, CMSgt(ret), CPOT, ABOC, COA

Lynn E. Lawrence is currently a national lecturer and an ophthalmic technician for Mills Eye and Facial Plastic Surgery. He is an approved speaker for the American Optometric Association, American Board of Opticianry, and Joint Commission for Allied Healthcare Personnel in Ophthalmology. Lynn currently develops training, compliance, and staff development materials as he has a passion to see others grow in their respective professions and in their advancement of certification.

### Saturday, March 25, 2023

9am-10am **The Lacrimal System – AOA CPC, ABO-2**

This course will discuss the flow of tears through the anatomical lacrimal system. It will cover the impact of the lacrimal system on vision, contact lens wear and overall eye health. A discussion will take place on the factors that impact proper tear health and tear flow.

10am-11am **Premium Customer Service - AOA CPC & ABO-GK**

This course is designed to enhance staff's customer service skills. A discussion of customer service techniques using real scenarios and current customer service techniques will be used. This interactive course will engage the audience in participation.

11am-1pm **NMOA Exhibitor Luncheon**

1pm-3pm **Anatomy and Physiology - AOA CPC, ABO-1 & NCLE-1**

This course is designed to teach an understanding of the eye and how it works. The course is designed to identify how the eye works from the source to the brain. The three layers of the eye, and the three chambers in the eye. This includes all the structures, muscles and their cranial nerves innervations, a tear film breakdown, and the visual pathway to the brain.

3pm-4pm **Basic Optics – AOA CPC & ABO-2**

Covers lens myopic, hyperopic, astigmatic, prism, and refractive qualities lens characteristics and the conditions that these lens are used for. The discussion will include conditions and terminology used in ocular optics.

4pm-5pm **What Every Tech Should Know About Diabetic Patients - AOA CPC, ABO-2 & NCLE-2**

This lecture will focus on what happens when an assistant discovers they are screening a diabetic patient. What they should do to prepare the patient for the doctor's examination. The different test, documentation and results for diabetics will be discussed (checklist provided)
